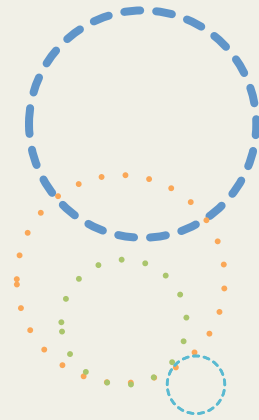

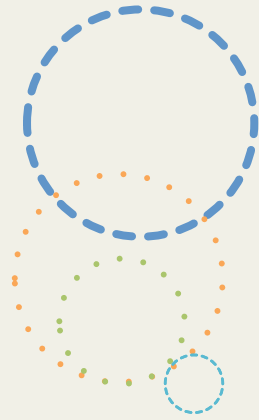

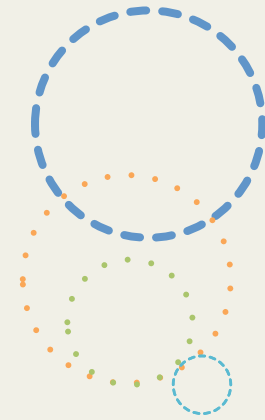
Peer Support Examples

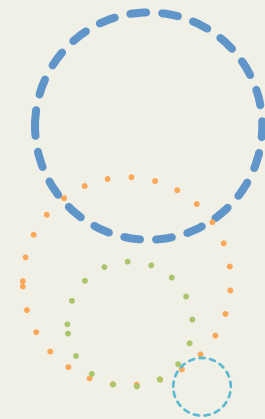

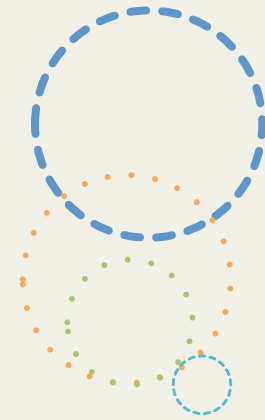
Encourage Peers to Initiate and Respond to the Child Appropriately

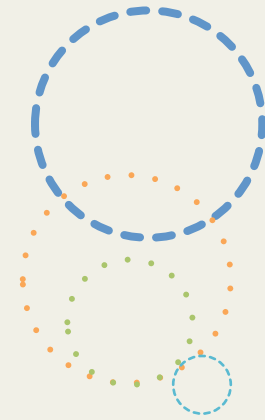


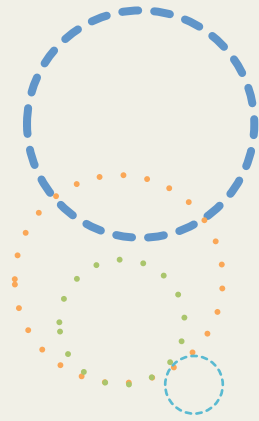




Enlist a Peer to Show the Child a New Skill
